Comment: Re-seeding was recently conducted in portions of the northern project area as mulch and young grasses observed. Revegetation is mature and progressing in other portions of the interim reclamation areas. Approximately 2000 Russian knapweeds observed.

Corrective Action: Control weeds at the appropriate time, and no later than 11/1/2020. Per CSU extension, control of Russian knapweeds requires a multi-pronged treatment approach as a single control strategy will not likely be sufficient. Areas treated for Russian knapweed should be reseeded with desirable perennial grasses in the fall to compete with the treated knapweed.
