7/15/2020 A thunderstorm occurred in the night and one of the production tanks was struck by lightening, an operator with Utah Gas Corp in the early hours on 7/16/2020 performing his normal duties found the two production tanks on fire. Emergency Response was activated and the fire department was called, the fire was consuming the condensate in both tanks and the fire department determined that the fire presented no risk to life or property, the fire department was put on standby in case of loss of containment of fire and spread to wild land.
