## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A geoprobe was utilized to advance a soil boring at the center of the former partially-buried produced water vessel to approximately 10 feet below ground surface (bgs). No groundwater was observed during assessment activities.

Soil samples were previously collected and analyzed. If future soil samples are needed, they will be analyzed for TPH and BTEX.

Based on dissolved phase petroleum hydrocarbon impacts beneath the site, groundwater monitoring will be conducted on a quarterly basis. Collected groundwater samples will be analyzed for BTEX until results are below COGCC Table 910-1 allowable limits for four consecutive quarters.

On October 15, 2019, an insitu chemical oxidation (COGAC™) injection event was performed in the vicinity of monitoring well TMW-4. A total of 8 injection points were advanced with injection intervals ranging from 12 to 17 feet below ground surface. A total of 1,000 pounds of COGAC™ was introduced to the subsurface intervals. Additional insitu chemical oxidation events will be performed during the first half of 2020.

A form 27A will be submitted prior to any remedial actions.
