 7/28/2020 COGCC staff observed an excavation located at the southwest corner of the YELLOW CREEK BRIDGE GAS PLANT (Facility ID 434309). Hydrovac material was stockpiled in a steel container and the excavated material was partially stockpiled on liner material. Both hydrovac and excavated material had a detectable hydrocarbon odor and some potential staining was observed. Impacted material from the spill/release was inadequately contained within the liner material.

Corrective Action: Properly store E&P waste per Rule 907.a and clean up per Rule 906.a.
 Location surface shall be sampled in areas where the impacted material was not properly stored on the liner material.
