Kerr-McGee hereby certifies that it has complied with the meeting requirements of Rule 306.e. A representative was available to meet with building unit owners who received an OGLA Notice or Buffer Zone Notice pursuant to Rule 305.c and requested a meeting regarding the proposed subject Oil and Gas Location. In compliance with Rule 306.b.(3), Kerr-McGee was also available to meet with such building unit owners if requested to do so by the Local Government Designee (LGD).

Kerr-McGee was contacted by a building unit owner within the buffer zone and subsequently met to address their concerns and answer questions. Their main concerns were regarding the view from their home, permanent lighting, an irrigation ditch which will be impacted during construction and the location of midstream pipelines. KMG committed to explore options for visual mitigation to the east of the facility such as fencing or a soil stockpile. Staff described how the lighting on the LACTs will be the only permanent lights and directed away from their home. The irrigation ditch which they utilize for farming operations on this parcel will be restored after interim reclamation. KMG has communicated the building unit owner's request to the midstream operator.
