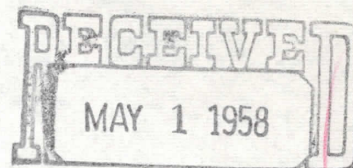

## SUNDRY NOTICES AND REPORTS ON WELLS



## INSTRUCTIONS

Notice must be given to the Director, and approval obtained in advance of the time when the owner or operator expects to recompleate or abandon a well or to change plans. Within thirty (30) days after recompleation, change of plans, or remedial work, a detailed report of the work done and the results obtained shall be submitted on this form in duplicate for wells on Patented and Federal lands, and in triplicate for wells on State lands. In work that affects only rods, pumps or tubing or other routine work such as, but not limited to, cleaning out to previous total depth, no report is necessary.

The Henderson #1-19 was spudded April 21, 1958. 8 5/8" 24# CF&I csg. 195' set at 203' K.B. and cmtd. w/175 sxs. reg. cmt. Drilled to 5640'. Cored 5640-90 full recovery no shows in core. Drilled to T.D. 5727'. Tops per elec. log. Niobrara 4722', "D" Sand 5543', "J" Sand 5627'. Skull Cr. 5718'. We propose to plug and abandon, setting a 50' plug opposite "J" Sand, 50' plug btm. of surface csg. and 15' plug top of surface casing.
