SUBJECT: COMPLETION INFORMATION WEBSTER NO. 1, NORTH
MCCALLUM FIELD - JACKSON COUNTY, COLORADO

Your letter of January 4, 1945, to J. C. Johnston has been referred to our department, and in checking over the information on Webster No. 1 which might be a part of a completion report, we find that the only additional information we could furnish your office would be a sample and core log and a note on core orientation.

Webster No. 1 was not Schlumbergered before the protection string of casing was run to 5099 feet. Therefore, the electric log we have for this well takes in only the interval from 5099 to 5414, the total depth.

While Mr. Brainerd was in Ponca City recently, Mr. French made a copy of his contour map on the North McCallum field. This map gives the structural position of Webster No. 1 and shows its structural relationship to the other wells in the field.

It is our understanding that a copy of the U.S.G.S. core analysis on Webster No. 1 has been furnished your office.

A satisfactory orientation was not obtained on runs made by Sperry-Sun on the core samples sent them, but indications pointed toward a southeast dip.
