of 5 1/2" OD, 14#, 8Rd Thread, electric weld, .244 gauge, Range 2, steel  
casing and 6' of hanger. Bottom of liner at 5413' with top at 5002', cemented  
with 35 sacks cement by International Cementers, Inc.
