Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depth to objective sands; show sizes, weights and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

Ran 304' (threads off) of new 10 3/4" O.D. 35.75, 8-Vthd. E. W. grade H-40 casing and landed at 313' from the Rotary Bushings and at 304' from the future pump derrick floor or ground level. Cemented with 185 sacks of cement by the International Cementers, Inc. Got cement returns. Size of hole 15".

After permitting cement to set 72 hours, tested casing with 300# pressure for 1 1/2 hours without loss of pressure.
