Best Management Practices

No	<u>BMP/COA Type</u>	<u>Description</u>
1	Storm Water/Erosion Control	Operator has installed stormwater controls, constructed in a manner that is consistent with good engineering practices, that will prevent offsite migration of sediment/contaminant, into the nearby sensitive areas. Stormwater controls have been installed prior to construction activities. Gas, oil, and water gathering lines are co-located to minimize potential of erosion associated with construction of any pipeline(s). Stormwater BMPs include a diversion ditch and earthen berm structure around the perimeter of the pad. Where appropriate, check dams will be installed to slow water flow and to capture sediment. Fiber rolls or equivalent will be installed at the toe of any slopes steep enough to wash out during storm events. All slopes shall be roughened using ripping or tilling equipment on the contours perpendicular to slopes. All disturbed surfaces will be armored utilizing mulch, riprap, or seeding techniques. Sediment traps and culverts will also be installed in areas of channeled water flow and will be protected by riprap.
2	Material Handling and Spill Prevention	The location includes automation equipment that allows operators to monitor pressures, rates, temperatures, valve positions and tank levels remotely. In the event that the facility is not operating under normal conditions, the automation system will immediately notify the operator. The automation system also has the ability to remotely perform an emergency shut down if necessary.
3	Material Handling and Spill Prevention	Separator berms shall be constructed of steel rings. All berms will be visually checked periodically to ensure proper working condition. Containment berms shall be constructed and designed to prevent leakage and resist degradation from erosion or routine operation. Tertiary containment, such as an earthen berm, will be installed as required for Production Facilities within 500 feet of a down gradient surface water feature. All berms will be visually checked periodically to ensure proper working condition. Separator berms will not be lined.
4	Material Handling and Spill Prevention	A 40 ml poly liner with foam type berms will be utilized under the drilling rig, mud tanks, shakers, and drill cuttings bins.
5	Construction	Site lighting is directed downward and inward and shielded so as to avoid glare on public roads and Building Units within one thousand (1000) feet. Once the drilling and completion rigs leave the site, there will be manually controlled lighting at the tank battery location as needed for safety purposes associated with the oil and gas operations. Such lighting will also be timer controlled to eliminate the full-time dusk to dawn lighting on the location.
6	Noise mitigation	<p>Operator will provide 32' engineered noise abatement sound walls to comply with COGCC requirements. Sound walls will be installed for the duration of drilling and completion activities per third party sound modeling studies. Walls will be installed on the Northeast, South, and East sides of the location.</p> <p>Baseline studies were conducted prior to commencement of construction and dirt work, which includes both A and C scale measurements. A sound model was developed with the drilling rig and completion operations noise signatures.</p> <p>Operator utilizes appropriately sized sound walls for instillation around production facility vapor recovery units to dampen noise. These walls are based on a forecasted model with the production facilities' noise signature.</p>
