Description of Sample Point:

Air sample from produced water tank headspace. Stainless steel tubing (1/4" dia.) extended from thief hatch at top of tank to approximately 1 foot above the water level. Sample collected via tubing connected to vacuum pump of portable analyzer and discharging to a tedlar bag.

Absolute Open Flow Potential 0 in CFPD (cubic feet per day)

Description of Release Potential and Duration (If flow is not open to the atmosphere, identify the duration in which the container or pipeline would likely be opened for servicing operations.):

Source is not flowing. Produced water tank T-501 is currently isolated prior to cleaning. A scavenger will be used to neutralize any H2S in the tank before opening to atmosphere.

Distance to nearest occupied residence, school, church, park, school bus stop, place of business, or other areas where the public could reasonably be expected to frequent: 1040 FEET

Distance to nearest Federal, State, County, or municipal road or highway owned and principally maintained for public use: 240 FEET

COMMENTS:

Our first action will be to clean T-501 and remove any potential for H2S being generated in the bottom of the tank. We are also collecting gas samples from individual wells to see if there have been any drastic changes to the makeup of our production gas stream. After the tank has been cleaned and the gas samples are consistent with previous analyses, we will evaluate water samples to see if the H2S is somehow dissolved in the water component of our production and it is breaking out in the tank. This analytical result for H2S is an order of magnitude higher than any concentration we have ever seen at any of our production locations and we intend to determine the source of this H2S occurrence.
