Max at least one of the crude tanks at the battery just to the south of the well is leaking crude oil as shown in the attached photos.

Control and contain spills/releases and clean up per Rule 906.a. Stopping the leak must be done immediately with free fluids to be cleaned up within 24 hours.

I will put in a formal inspection notice by tomorrow morning but this email serves as your first and only notice to take the actions listed above.
