Such markings, placards, and labels must be retained on the container until it is sufficiently cleaned

of residue and purged of vapors to remove any potential hazards.} This container falls under the 10 bbl requirement, however HRR realizes the sign that was on the container was faded. HRR covered that information and only the required markings remain.
