COMMENTS:

The Bradenhead test dated 9/9/2020 had an initial pressure of over 50psi. Extraction was unable to successfully mitigate the bradenhead pressure through a blowdown strategy. Per Operator Guidance Order NO. 1-232 Extraction submits the following as an alternate Bradenhead mitigation strategy:

To comply with the operator guidance Extraction requests to route the bradenhead gas to a catadyne heater within 20' of the wellhead to maintain bradenhead pressure below the 50psi threshold. Extraction has left the bradenhead shut-in after completing the bradenhead blowdown mitigation strategy.

Bradenhead gas is not to be vented to the atmosphere; any gas from the Bradenhead will be routed to catadyne heater. Shut in bradenhead pressure shall not exceed 50 psig. Operator shall implement measures to get an estimate of the gas flow rate and/or volume from the bradenhead.</p> <p>3. Within thirty days of 09/28/2021 , submit a Form 4 Sundry that summarizes current well condition. The sundry should include details of the future plans, sample analysis interpretation, bradenhead test description, and the flow rate information and pressure data.</p> <p>4. If a sample has not been collected from surface casing within the last twelve months collect bradenhead gas samples for laboratory analysis. Sampling shall comply with Operator Guidance - Bradenhead Testing and Reporting Instructions, Appendix A: Liquid and Gas Sampling. Copies of all final laboratory analytical results shall be provided to the COGCC within three months of collecting the samples.</p>
