We will excavate all impacted soils from the pit and dispose of at North Weld Landfill located in Ault. Confirmation samples will be collected from all 4 walls and pit bottom to ensure all hydrocarbon impacted soil was removed. Samples for inorganics will be collected from each wall, along with a background sample to compare to. If the samples results exceed table 910-1 standards then the inorganic impacted soil will be buried in the pit not to exceed 3 ft. from surface. If we have excessive inorganic impacted soil that will exceed 3 ft. from surface in the pit, then this soil will be disposed of at North Weld Landfill in Ault.
