I received your voicemail and thought I would follow up with an email. I spoke to our completions group about our schedule in regards to the A&W pumps at the Dreamweaver location. I believe that we will be finished hydraulic fracturing the wells at the end of this month or the first week in February. This should result in us not needing the A&W pumps which are located in the winter roost area. However, there is a chance that we will need water for the well drill out and we may have A&W leave a single pump in its current location. In the event that water is needed the work in the area should be very limited and we will make sure that the work is done only during the 10am-2pm window.
