One thing that is clear and that is the 2A has no mention or planning for a water pumping operation on File's property. As we mentioned in our complaint, it's a new location and it needs separate approval based on HPH restrictions. We will also refile complaint once New Rules are in place, as the the pumping operation will fall under new rules as of the 15th.

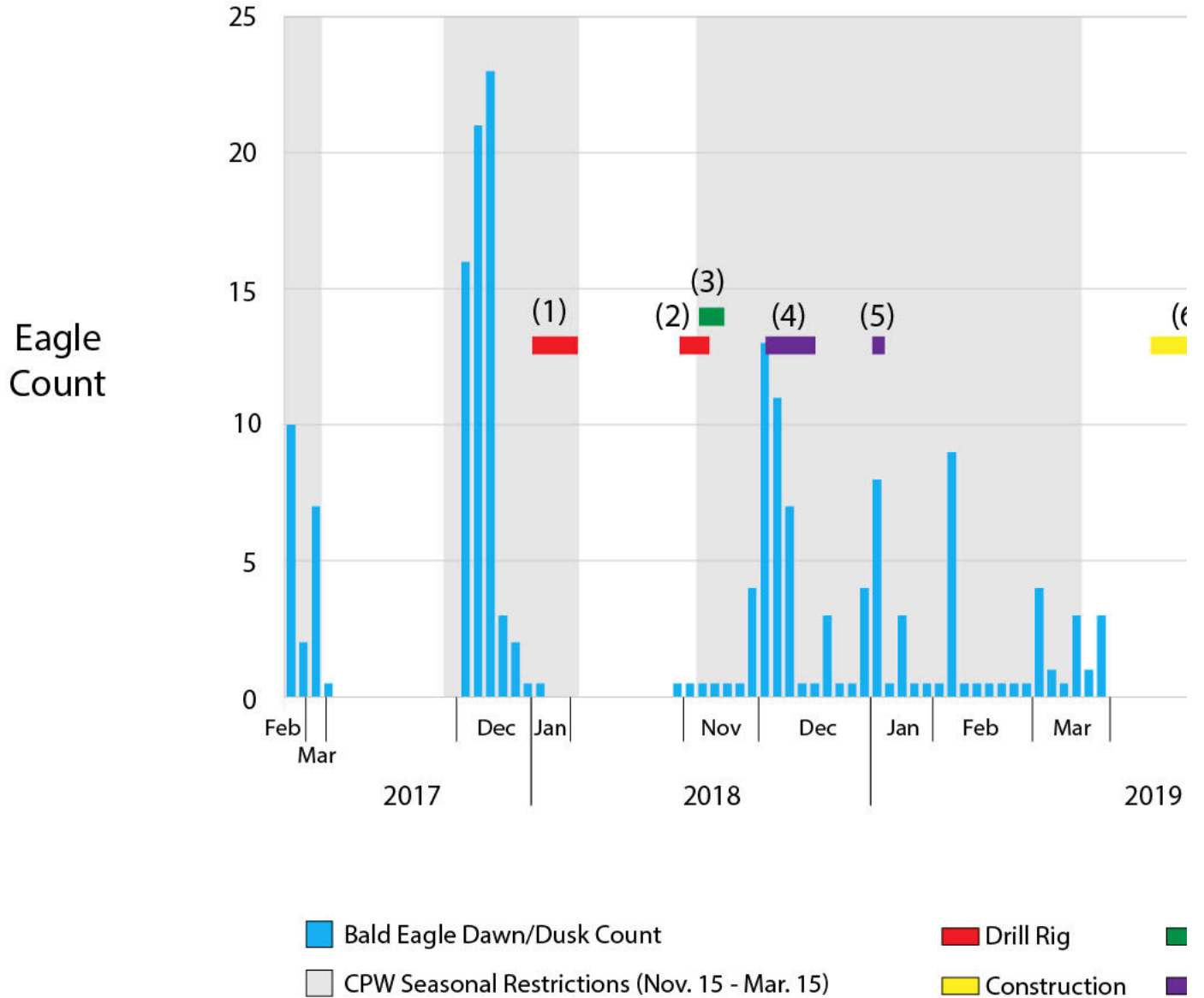
