INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

The Deines 31-14 well associated with the DEINES-67N66W production facility is being plugged and abandoned. The flowline is being completely removed and the production facility is being decommissioned. This submittal is associated with closure of the production facility.

PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? (Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples):

Five soil samples will be collected from the produced water sump excavation and one soil sample will be collected from beneath each above ground storage tank (AST) and separator. In the absence of any elevated PID readings, soil samples collected from the base of the produced water sump excavation, each AST, and each separator will be submitted for laboratory analysis of TPH (C6-C36), BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene, 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene, pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The analytical results will be compared to COGCC Table 915-1. Soil associated with any onsite flowline and dumlaine removals will also be field screened visually and with a PID. If any visual staining or any PID readings exceeding background VOC concentrations are observed anywhere onsite or at any field screening location, soil samples from those locations will also be submitted for laboratory analysis. A Soil Investigation Map is attached.

Proposed Groundwater Sampling

Will groundwater samples be collected as part of this investigation? (Number, analyses, and locations of samples):

Groundwater is not expected to be encountered during facility decommissioning. If groundwater is encountered, one grab sample will be collected from each area groundwater has accumulated and samples will submitted for laboratory analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene, and 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene. Analytical results will be compared to COGCC Table 915-1.

A minimum of one soil sample will be collected from an adjacent, undisturbed location to document inorganic background concentrations. The soil sample (s) will be field screened by an independent 3rd party consultant for visual staining and VOCs will be measured with a properly calibrated PID. The soil sample(s) will be placed on hold at the laboratory.
