CORRECTIVE ACTION

Describe immediate response (how stopped, contained and recovered): <u>The 4" poly production water line was isolated by two valves. A vacuum truck recovered 15 bbls of produced water from the trench where the release pooled. Additionally, BBC contractors flushed the spill area with 100 bbls of fresh water. The open trench is currently fenced as a safety precaution.</u>
The Multa Trina Ditch, 60 feet south of the release, is not flowing and was not impacted.
Describe any emergency pits constructed: <u>NA</u>
How was the extent of contamination determined? <u>Soil samples were collected from the spill area, field screened, and submitted for laboratory analysis.</u>
Further remediation activities proposed (attach separate sheet if needed): <u>Four soil samples were collected at various depths from the extent of the spill area on 4/14/10 and were submitted for analysis of BTEX, TPH (C6-C28), PAHs, Table 910-1 Metals, EC, pH, and SAR. BBC will submit a subsequent Form 27 to the COGCC once the analytical results have been received. See attached Figures 1 and 2.</u>
Describe measures taken to prevent problem from reoccurring: <u>Additional measures will be taken when processing line locate requests.</u>

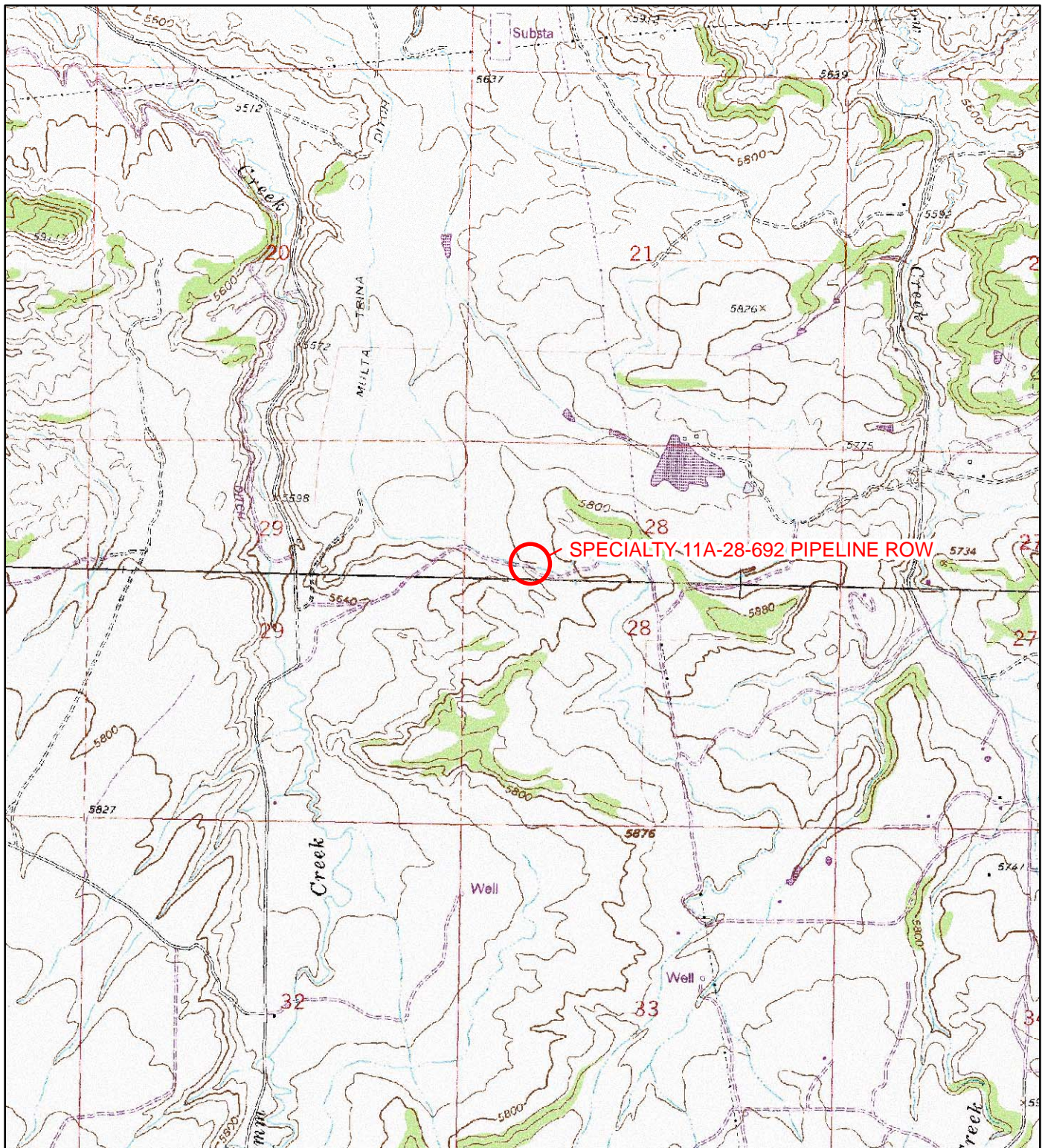

 SITE LOCATION

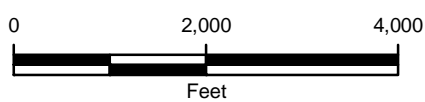
