Dear Ms. Friesen:

This letter is in response to your request requiring no further action regarding the DCU-35 (B1) spill remediation. The U.S. Forest Service (FS) has reviewed the Remedial Action Report sent to Ms. Olivia Garcia on June 3, 2010 that included excavation and sampling results, clearance documentation, and evidence of waste disposal for remediation of the site. Upon a satisfactory review of the Remedial Action Report and a site visit on June 28, 2010 with representatives from EnCana, the FS finds the physical remediation of the DCU-35 spill to be acceptable and requiring no further remedial action.

However, as discussed during the site visit on June 28, 2010, continued monitoring of the spill site reclamation, to ensure successful long term stabilization of the site, is required. This includes continued monitoring of the re-vegetation status, sediment controls, and noxious weeds. If the FS identifies additional work that needs to be completed for long term site stabilization, a FS representative will contact EnCana notifying them of the work that needs to be completed. EnCana remains the responsible party for the reclamation of the DCU-35 spill site until notified by a FS representative their responsibility has been relieved.
