April 26th - April 30th - Monitor weed growth and conduct application of Roundup.

April 30th - May 7th - 7 day wait period after Roundup application.

May 10th - May 14th - No-till drill seeding of PBSI Native Prairie Seed Mix

The seed mix was chosen based on laboratory results from soil samples collected from the access road and former well pad that exhibited elevated salinity levels. See attached lab results and seed mix.

Based on monitoring of the revegetation, approximately 1-2 months following seeding, weeds will be mowed.
