Grab confirmation soil samples will be collected from beneath the above ground condensate tank and well head. Soil samples will be analyzed by a certified laboratory for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per COGCC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, and boron. All samples collected will be analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved COGCC laboratory analysis methods.

	It is proposed that one soil sample taken to characterize the tank battery. This tank battery has a history of observed hydrocarbon impacts. A minimum of two samples shall be collected at the Tank Battery and keen observation used during investigation.
	During abandonment procedure, the Operator shall observe soil for any sign of impact such as; odor, black or grey staining, salt impacts, wax, etc. Any area of suspected impact shall be; reported and delineated with soil analytical for Table 915-1.
	Proposed sample locations are approved, however if impacts are suspected at other locations, confirmation samples may be taken at those locations.
	Samples location selection should be guided by rule 915.e.(2)B.
	Per Rule 911.b. If a spill is discovered during closure activities, a Form 19 spill report shall be filled. (Per 912.b.(1)E. spill is defined as >10cuyd of contaminated soil. )
	The operator shall ensure that Flowline abandonment rule 1105.e. requirements are met. Flowline abandonment details shall be included on supplemental report.
