## BRADENHEAD TEST REPORT

Step 1. Record all tubing and casing pressures as found.  
Step 2. Sample now, if intermediate or surface casing pressure >25 psi. in sensitive areas, 1 psi.  
Step 3. Conduct intermediate casing test.  
Step 4. Conduct intermediate casing test.  
Step 5. Send report to BLM within 30 days and to OGCC within 10 days. Include wellbore diagram if not previously submitted or if wellbore configuration has changed since prior program. Attach gas and liquid analyses if sampled.
