Each composite sample will consist of 5 bits of cuttings from various depths combined into one composite sample sent in for analysis. Along with the 2 composite samples, there will be 1 floor sample and 4 wall samples collected. Seven (7) total samples to be analyzed by the lab for compliance with concentration levels in Table 915-1. Refer to pages 1 and 2 of the attached exhibit.
