Four additional background composite samples were collected (SS01-SS04) at the base of the pit on 10/29/20 after pit construction and prior to use. These samples were analyzed for Table 910-1 inorganic constituents as Table 915-1 was not yet adopted. These samples are included on the analytical results table and the laboratory data is included in the attachments.

On May 19, 2021 five soil samples were collected from the base and sidewalls of the pit. Two additional composite samples of the cuttings material were collected from the mixed soil and drill cuttings. These samples were analyzed for Table 915-1 constituents. Approximate sample locations are shown on the 'Soil Sample Location' figure. All 915-1 constituents except SAR, EC, Boron and Arsenic are below COGCC Table 915-1 limits. Arsenic values are within 1.25x of background. Operator requests permission to backfill the pit with clean fill and leave inorganics in place approximately 4' below ground surface.
