

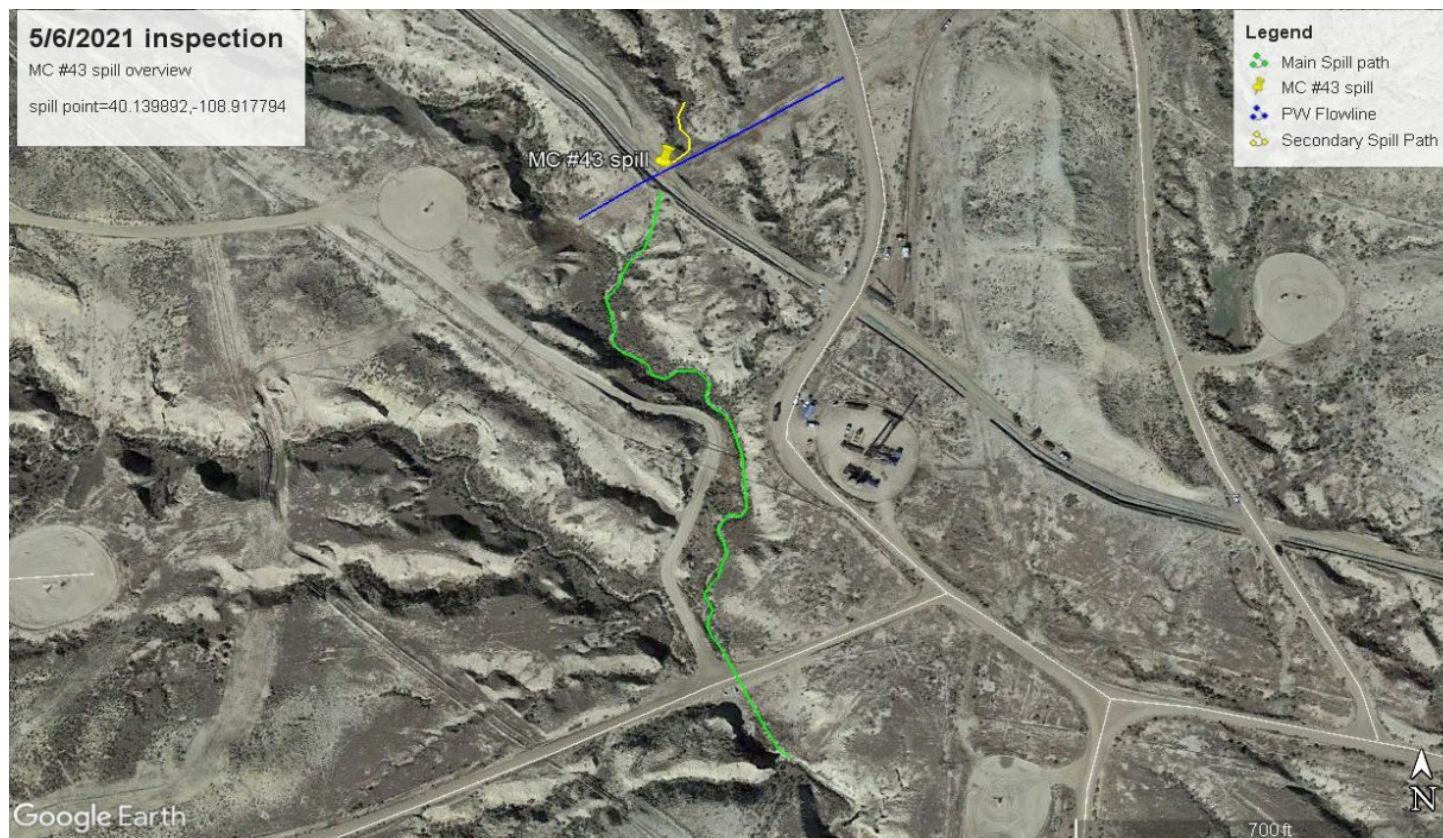

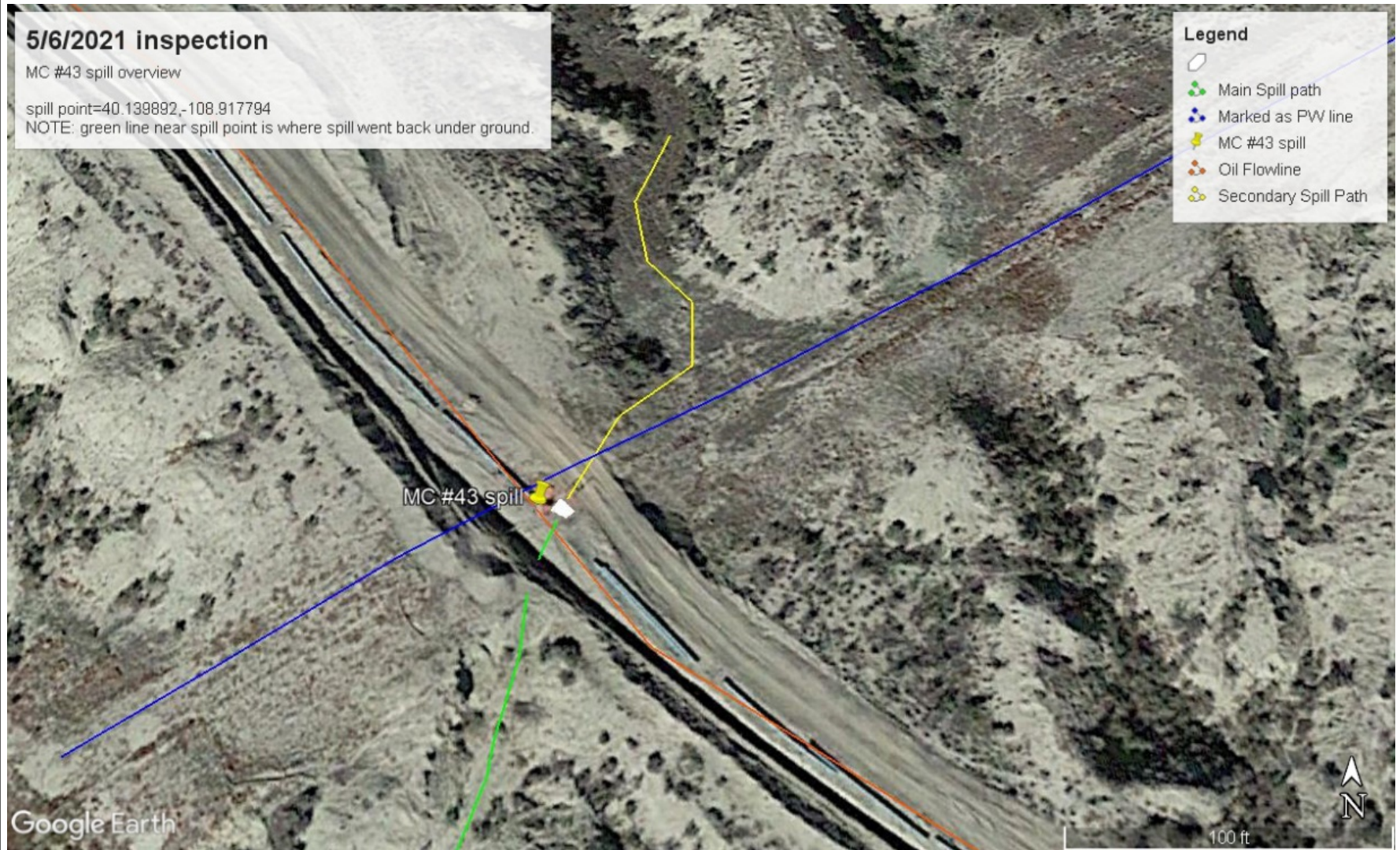

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Photo #1 looking south west. Spill originated inside the orange fence. There is a valve box, flowline appeared to be ~7feet deep. Note the Two separate spill paths; the Main spill path flowed mostly south (left of photo), flowed approx. 1400ft. The Secondary spill path flowed to the north into an adjacent small basin, traveled approx. 170 feet.



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Photo #2 close up of photo#1 It appeared that the spill day-lighted near the valve box, and split into two flow paths. Photo taken looking to the southwest.



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Photo #3 looking south-southwest. It appeared that produced water found a pathway through what appeared to be a Reclamation area. There was a “Notice of Reclamation” Sign nearby, implying this area.

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Photo #5 Looking to the Northeast vertical shadow to right of photo appears to be where spilled fluid day-lighted and made its way down grade.
