We had a state reportable release this afternoon at the location noted below due to a release daylighting from the subsurface. This release is currently controlled. The impacted soil was discovered while performing a pressure test at the facility. Excavation activities are being scheduled and a Form 19 Release Report is forthcoming. This release did not threaten Waters of the State, Public Water System, residences or occupied structures, livestock, wildlife, air quality, or publicly-maintained roads.
