Five (5) discrete soil samples will be collected from the base of the produced water vessel (~4 ft below ground surface) to verify soil was not impacted from the operation of the pit. Analysis for grab samples included TPH (DRO & GRO), BTEX, pH, EC, and SAR. See attached site map for partially buried vessel location and proposed sampling locations.
