Comment: Site had open excavation at site of former buried concrete vault produced water vessel without effective or adequate means of excluding entry of people, livestock or wildlife at time of inspection. Open excavation was part of site investigation and remediation project 14115 which remains open and is documented in attached photo. The lack of adequate fencing has been noted in previous inspections.

Corrective Action: maintain best management practices to control and contain all spills/releases of E&P waste to protect the environment, public health, safety and welfare and the environment as required by rule 913.b(5)B.i which requires that Operators will fence or cover open remediation excavations to prevent access when sites are not attended. The site was not attended at the time of the inspection.
