#### **Other Potential Receptors within 1/4 mile**

The UPRR Meyer 1 former location is surrounded by pasture land and cultivated fields in all directions. There is one ephemeral stream mapped approximately 200 feet west. There are two domestic water wells and two residential structures mapped within ¼ mile of the location. Depth to groundwater is unknown, however, one boring advanced in November 2016 to 50 feet did not encounter ground water. Based on the Division of Water Resources, Groundwater Levels in the Lost Creek Designated Groundwater Basin paper published in 2020, it is anticipated that the depth to water will be approximately 125 feet. There are no sensitive areas or wildlife habitats identified within a quarter mile of the former location. See the attached Figures 1, 2, and 3 for an illustration of the Site.

### INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

The equipment has been removed from the UPRR Meyer 1 site. A site investigation conducted in November 2016 indicated the presence of soil impacts greater than the COGCC Table 910-1 TPH standards beneath the former produced water pit to a maximum depth of approximately 5 feet. The attached Figure 2 illustrates the soil sampling data.

Great Western will conduct site investigation activities, field screening, and confirmation sampling activities during closure in accordance with COGCC 900 Series Rules. Discrete soil samples will be collected and analyzed pursuant to Rule 915, following the general sample collection guidance in Rule 915.e. (2).

Please refer to the attached Site Investigation Report for a summary of the subsurface site investigation actions conducted at the Site on June 22, 2021.

Great Western proposes to conduct further site investigation at the UPRR Meyer 1 location as shown on the attached Proposed Soil Borings - Figure 5. Two additional borings will be advanced utilizing an auger rig to a depth of 50 feet. Soil samples from the borings will be analyzed for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, total xylenes (BTEX), naphthalene, trimethylbenzenes and Total Volatile Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TVPH [C6-C10]) by EPA Method 8260 and Total Extractable Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TEPH [C10-C36]) by EPA Method 8015. Analytical results for TVPH and TEPH will be added together to calculate Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH).
