While completing this form it was realized that one additional confirmation sample in addition to the PBWV sample was taken while the COA requested three confirmation samples in addition to the PBWV sample. This form does request final closure as field screening (AVO) showed that all the stained soil was on surface and hydrocarbons had burned away in the fire... the stained soil was essentially ash from the fire. Approximately 400 square feet of soil 2 inches deep was removed and hauled to disposal.

Please let me know if an additional two confirmation samples are required and I will be happy to grab them and send in another 27S.
