COMMENTS:

The HSR-GAGE 5-17 well was added to the abatement program on 5/11/2021. There were two blow downs performed on this well. The first blow down on 7/9/2021 began at 9 psi and collected 0 Mcf of gas and collected 0.1 gallons of fluid from the bradenhead but did not flow. There was not enough fluid to sample. The second blow down on 8/23/2021 began at 9psi and collected 0 Mcf of gas and collected 0 gallons of fluid from the bradenhead but did not flow. There was not enough flow to register through the blow down equipment for either blow down. On 8/30/2021, a Form 17 was completed with a starting pressure of 9 psi and an ending pressure of 0 psi. After the two blow downs and the most recent Form 17 we have not seen any improvement on this well, therefore we are electing to plug this well by 3/1/2022. We will continue to monitor and blow down as necessary, until the well has been plugged

Operator will implement measures to control venting, to protect health and safety, and to ensure that vapors and odors from well operations do not constitute a nuisance or hazard to public welfare.2. Prior to starting bradenhead mitigation, if a sample has not been collected within the last twelve months collect bradenhead and production gas samples for laboratory analysis. Sampling will comply with Operator Guidance - Bradenhead Testing and Reporting Instructions, Appendix A: Liquid and Gas Sampling. Copies of all final laboratory analytical results will be provided to the COGCC within three months of collecting the samples.3. Operator will implement measures to get an initial estimate of the gas flow rate and/or volume from the bradenhead. During the shut-in period record pressure data to adequately characterize the build-up. This mitigation plan may be used for six consecutive months from the date test reported on the Form 17.4. By 3/1/2022 this well must be plugged and a Form 4 Sundry submitted which details mitigation efforts prior to abandonment. The sundry should include details of the sample analysis interpretation, and the flow rate information and pressure data. <p>Shut in bradenhead pressure shall not exceed 50 psig.</p>
