This form is being submitted to comply with COGCC Rule 911.a.a(4). The form serves as the initial notification to abandon the 3 inch aluminum pipeline in place.

PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? (Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples):

As part of the abandonment in place of the off-location aluminum flowline, Caerus will excavate the two ends of the off-location flowline to complete flushing, pressure testing, and capping of the line. Following capping of the pipeline, Caerus will visually inspect and field screen the base and sidewalls of the excavation on each end of the flowline. If field screening indicates impacts associated with the flowline, Caerus will collect soil samples to delineate the vertical and horizontal extents of impacted material to COGCC Table 915-1 standards. Any impacted soil will be segregated onsite for characterization and handling following COGCC rules. If no impacts are observed during field investigation, one sample will be collected from the base of the flowline excavation end exhibiting the highest degree of impacts through field screening for laboratory analysis of the full list of constituents in COGCC Table 915-1.

Proposed Groundwater Sampling

Will groundwater samples be collected as part of this investigation? (Number, analyses, and locations of samples):

Groundwater is not expected to be encountered. In the event that groundwater is encountered during investigation activities associated with this project, the COGCC will be notified, and a representative sample will be collected and submitted for laboratory analysis for constituents listed in COGCC Table 915-1.
