If you've tagged at 700', you're good to go, no need to tag again. You must tag the 224' plug at 124' or higher though.

Nick... we're doing it again....

Pumped 31bbls of cement for the Fox Hills plug from 850 to 650. We based it off the assumed bore from the prior tag of 10.5" bore, then added 50% excess. Turns out this has some SERIOUS washout, and we tagged that monstrosity at 700'. Calculates out to 14.5" bore. We're planning to pump a 100' plug with an assumed 14.5" bore for a total of 20.5 bbls to top off in the AM. Are we good to skip tagging this thing after another monster top off?

Trying to avoid messing around in this thing too much more, it's starting to deteriorate fast and all of the freshwater displacements aren't helping.

We have cementers standing by so hopeful for a quick answer.
