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Photo 4. Facing west toward the location. Vegetation has not adequately established and bare areas have compacted soils. It appears the soils were not cross ripped as required. This area needs to be decompacted and reclaimed.



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Photo 5. West side of the location facing east. There are rows of compacted soil where vegetation is sparse. This area has not adequately re-established to 80% reference area levels.
