Additional Spill Details Not Provided Above:

At around 2230 on 11/8/21 we had just pumped a 208' cement plug on top of a CIBP set at 6489'. While pulling TBG out of cement well kicked, pushing CICB and cement plug up hole 115', by tag the next day. We had well set up to flow CSG to the flat tank and with a gas kick we blew oil and fresh water out of the flat tank on the ground. The 2" valve below washington head on BOP was open as well for well monitoring and blew oil and fresh water out of it around the wellhead. All fluid was contained around the wellhead and equipment. Oil was skimmed with a vac truck and water pulled and put into production tanks on location.
