COMMENTS:

The South East Campo Unit (SECU) is a federal secondary recovery unit that is zone specific to the Lansing C zone. The SECU has been shut in since 1/1/2019 because it was uneconomic to operate. Murfin plans on dissolving the SECU as a secondary recovery unit and submitting a comingling and allocation application with the BLM so Murfin can test the Neva formation using the existing wellbores and if productive use the existing surface equipment (pipelines, and tanks). Therefore, this well has been shut-in since 1/1/2019. A successful MIT was performed 5/11/2021. The Lansing C zone is open down hole. The well is secured with tubing setting in a tubing head at surface with valve and bull plug in the top of tubing. A Form 2 to workover this well will be submitted in the future.
