Re: Mt. Hope Field

Dear Sir;

On June 11, 1985 a site inspection of your Mt. Hope Field was made. During the course of my inspection I was informed by John Moore that the Mt. Hope #16 had been converted to a water injection well. Our records do not reflect our approval for conversion and injection. This is a direct violation of our rules and regulations. You are required to submit a Form 4 requesting approval, a schematic diagram of the present well-bore configuration and documentation of a casing pressure test. You are also required to submit documentation of one of the following: a tracer survey, cement bond log or temperature survey. This information must be received by July 17, 1985 or the well will be shut-in until our requirements are met. In the future for all new injection wells in an approved secondary recovery project it will be necessary to follow this procedure before injection commences.

On your monthly Form 14 report I also noticed that you're showing the Mt. Hope #10 as temporarily abandoned. At the time of my inspection the Mt. Hope #10 was actively injecting water. This discrepancy in reporting is to be remedied immediately. All prior reports reflecting the Mt. Hope #10 as temporarily abandoned where there was injection are to be re-submitted with the correct information provided. In addition, there is a discrepancy between your reported monthly pressures and our observed field inspection pressures. We would appreciate your looking into this matter. It is highly important that accurate information is submitted.
