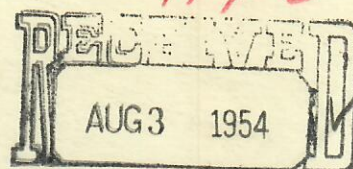

 of cement will be set between the depths of 225' and 245'. Surface pipe was set
 at a depth of 239' and will be plugged with 10 sacks in the top thereof.
