Dear Don:

As we discussed on the phone, it is my understanding that the work to be performed on the Dubois lease in section 7-9N-52W in Logan County will consist of sucking out the water and oil from the pit just south of the tanks and subsequently closing up that pit, since you now have a circulating pump at the battery. I have discussed the work to be done with Les Jackson, your pumper, during my field visit on September 6th. Further, you have stated that you will dig a waste pit at the Dubois lease and bury the oily dirt that is there.

Fluharty's have also expressed concern about the state of the fence surrounding the pit at the Arco-Sindt well in section 6-9N-52W. If you have further use for this pit, please arrange to have it adequately fenced or, if no further use is foreseen, you could get it closed at the same time you have equipment working to bury the dirt over at the Dubois battery.

I urge you to work with Fluharty's to resolve any conflicts you may have with them over the damages they have suffered when their dog got into the pit last week. I look forward to the completion of the work by September 20, 1991. As always, if you have questions about this letter don't hesitate to contact me.
