



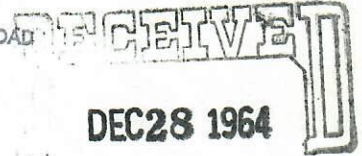


The Toltek Drilling Company referred your note in regard to the present status of the above captioned well.

This well, at the present time, is testing on pump, with a production rate of approximately 375 barrels of fluid per day of which 15 barrels are oil.

Some delay in the test was caused by rods parting. This test is not considered conclusive, due to the well not having pumped down. Previous swab tests indicated 25% oil. Prior to the rods parting, the water decreased with an increase of oil. We should be able to give a final gauge before January 1, 1965 with the completion report.

Any final report given before pumping the well down would be inaccurate.
