Gentlemen:

Rex Monahan filed with your agency for stripper well category classification (Section 108 of the NGPA) on or about March 30, 1979 for the captioned well. The well had produced less than 60 Mcf per day for the last 90 days prior to the filing.

This well has now produced at an average rate of 67 Mcf per day for the 90-day production period commencing April 1, 1981 and ending June 30, 1981.

Pursuant to §271.805 of the regulations under the NGPA, this letter is our written notice to you, the FERC, and Rex Monahan (the operator) that the #1 Minnie Smith gas well located in Section 29-T12N-R52W, Logan County, Colorado is no longer qualified as a stripper gas well based on production for the 90-day production period from April 1, 1981 through June 30, 1981.
