Gentlemen:

Enclosed is an application to drill our #1 Meier well in section 23, T12N, R52W, Logan County, Colorado. The proposed location is 300 feet from the Colorado-Nebraska state line and as such is an exception location. We enclose a copy of our prospect map showing the seismic interpretation on which we are drilling this wildcat. As is evident from the map, the structure is small and quite sharp. We have placed the well in the optimum location in order to reduce our risk as much as possible. The mineral ownership on either side of the state line is common and we have included a copy of the lease, title memo and title opinion covering section 23 and adjoining section 21 in Nebraska.


To support our application we enclose a letter from the Nebraska Oil and Gas Commission waiving objection to the location.
