Mr. Allred,

Thank you for your response regarding access to the Woodward 1 location. However, providing temporary access is not adequate as it is not always clear when I will be available to visit the site, and need to have access at all reasonable times (Rule 204). We ask that you work with the surface owner and provide a key/gate code, or install a COGCC lock (with landowner permission) to the gate so it can be inspected during business hours. At this point I am the only Reclamation Inspector in the Northwest that will have this access, and you can assure the landowner that I will not access the land for anything other than oil and gas inspection duties allowed under the Oil and Gas Act. It is a common practice that Operator's throughout the state work with surface owners to facilitate inspections in this way. Until I am provided with a means for access at all reasonable times, this Location will not be placed on my list for priority bond release inspection.
