Comments Verdad is refiling this application for permit to drill, original permit expiration was on 05/10/2020. Verdad is changing the well name, SHL, TPZ and BHL from the original permit.  
The nearest well completed or permitted in the same formation is the Helen 2536-07H, measured is 2D using GIS mapping.  
The nearest existing or proposed well belonging to another operator is the L.E.Gerkin 09H API# 05-123- 44072 operated by Red Hawk Petroleum LLC, DG well status . This distance was measured in 3D using an anti collision report, attached as "other".  
This well has a bottom hole location beyond the unit boundary setback. The bottom of the completed interval will be within the unit boundary setback 460'FSL and 2445' FEL of section 36. The wellbore beyond the unit boundary setback will be physically isolated and will not be completed.

Pressure testing shall be conducted and the documented results shall be retained by the operator for inspection by the Director for a period of one (1) year. 3	Drilling/Completion Operations	Alternative Logging Program - One of the first wells drilled on the pad will be logged with Open Hole Resistivity Log and Gamma Ray Log from the kick-off point to into the surface casing. All wells on the pad will have a cement bond log with gamma-ray run on production casing (or on intermediate casing if production liner is run) into the surface casing. The horizontal portion of every well will be logged with a measuredwhile-drilling gamma-ray log. The form 5, Completion Report, for each well on the pad will list all logs run and have those logs attached. The Form 5 for a well without openhole logs shall clearly state "Alternative Logging Program - No open-hole logs were run" and shall clearly identify (by API#, well name & number) the well in which openhole logs were run.
