The subject well was plugged and abandoned on 11-5-66 as follows:  
Killed well with water, pulled tubing and R-3 packer. The 4-1/2" OD 9.5# production casing was left in well. Tripped in open ended tubing and spotted 5 sx cement plug at 1920'-1970' KB. Set surface cement plug and regulation marker.
