Dear Mr. Rogers:

Continental Oil Company submitted and received approval on two "Intent to Abandon" notices on the Bourg No. 1, C SE SE, Section 7, T9N, R78W, and the McCallum Unit No. 23, NW SE, Section 18, T9N, R78W, Jackson County, Colorado, during December, 1963.

Follow-up requests for plugging records brought a reply by Mr. J. O. O'Neal of our Casper District Production office on October 12, 1964. Mr. O'Neal stated therein that it was our intention to defer abandonment until field evaluation of a gas adsorption system for the area could be made. Further, he asked that the Sundry Notices be returned and that if abandonment was desirable, the Notices would be re-submitted.

Additional study has shown that abandonment of these wells is desirable; consequently, the Sundry Notices for P&A are enclosed for your approval.
