The attached application for permit, survey plat, and filing fee is submitted for your review and approval.

The well has been staked at a location within Section 14, which will allow the minimum amount of surface damage due to dirt work construction. The location within the Section is an exception to the normal footage requirement for a legal location. However, the minimum distance from the nearest lease line (517') is a distance measured from a federal lease held by Jack J. Grynberg in the north half of the south half of Section 14.

We request that you review the attached documents at your earliest possible convenience and please advise if you need anything further to approve this application.

We presently have a drilling rig standing by to begin work as soon as the necessary approval can be obtained. Your earliest possible attention to this matter will be greatly appreciated.
