 On 2-22-2022, I Randy Silver area field inspector was assigned a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to Odor. The complainant Kelsey Barnholt 480 gold Hill Dr Erie CO stated the issues were occurring on I 25 and exit 224
 On 2-24-22, I attempted to make contact with the complainant who indicated that on 2-17-22 complainant experienced an intense odor like chemicals and propane while driving on I 25 she did not know where the odor was coming from.
 I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I did not smell any unusual odors in or around location. At time of inspection, all operations appear to have not changed.
 At time of inspection, I spoke with drilling supervisor he stated at time of complaint they were drilling and no unusual activity was taking place.
