INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

If impacted soils are encountered, as exhibited by visible oil, staining, odor, or elevated field readings, emergency response measures taken will include excavation and temporarily stockpiling soils on location. Impacted soils will be disposed off-location at a commercial disposal facility. Confirmation soil samples will be collected, submitted for laboratory analysis of Table 915-1 parameters. Currently the investigation is expected to start 10 days after the project is awarded and is proposed for 04/11/2022.

Soil samples will be collected from around the Kalcevic 33-3 wellhead and at the ends of the off-location flowline(s). At a minimum grab soil samples will be collected from beneath the aboveground storage tanks, separator, loadout, and any areas of stained soils. Soil samples will be analyzed for Table 915-1 parameters and results will be compared with Table 915-1 concentrations or levels.
